Adesto Technologies recognizes the need to address issues associated with Conflict Minerals and is taking steps to ensure that our products do not contain or utilize minerals from regions in and around the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC).

Adesto Technologies fully supports the position of the EICC and the Global e-sustainability (GeSi) Initiative in avoiding the use of conflict minerals which directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) or adjoining countries, in line with full compliance to the EICC's Electronic Industry Code of Conduct.

Adesto Technologies is committed to a policy that require our supply chain does not procure Gold, Tantalum, Tungsten or Tin that originates from the DRC and adjoining countries. Adesto Technologies is working with our suppliers to identify the smelters and mine sources. Adesto Technologies will rely on the EICC/GeSi third party audits of smelters or other sources as part of its due diligence and comply with the Dodd Franks Act and subsequent SEC requirement.
